Canada's former ambassador to China, Guy Saint-Jacques, says there's little chance that Canadian Robert Schellenberg, who has been sentenced to death for drug trafficking, will successfully appeal his sentence.

It's a scenario Saint-Jacques, who



B.C., was tried in 2016 for smuggling 222 kilograms of methamphetamines and given 15 years in jail. On Monday, in a one-day trial, a Chinese court sentenced him to death.

Prime Minister Justin Trudeau requested clemency for

represented Canada in China from 2012 until 2016, understands well. During those years, he advocated on behalf of a Canadian who was sentenced to execution in 2015.

At the time, Saint-Jacques served as a conduit between Canada's Ministry of Foreign Affairs, consulate diplomats and Chinese officials. Then-Prime Minister Stephen Harper eventually stepped in, asking for leniency.

"I went to deliver this ... personal letter of Prime Minister Harper to President Xi Jinping calling for clemency," Saint-Jacques told Day 6.

The man - who, like Schellenberg, was convicted of drug trafficking - was killed the next day.

Schellenberg, from Abbotsford,

if they behave well for two years, this will be commuted to a life sentence. And so in this case it was only that sentence.

So there's a sense of urgency, then, around this case. How likely do you think it is that Robert Schellenberg would be executed?

Well, based on precedence I think, unfortunately, it's likely.

In the Chinese judicial system, once you are formally charged, you are found guilty in 99.9 per cent of the cases and ... it's very rare that the verdict will be overturned or changed.

And once the final verdict is given, people usually don't sit very long on death row before the execution takes place. Obviously, in this case, I expect that there have been already a number of demarches that have taken place in Beijing, done by the embassy, and that more will be done in the future.

But the fact that this has been politicized, as you say, does that present some hope for Mr. Schellenberg? Does that mean that there may be a path where Canadian officials and Chinese officials can negotiate a way to stop this from happening?

In many ways, what I see happening right now is very similar to what we went through from 2014 to 2016 when the Chinese detained Julia and Kevin Garratt

swap, the conversation would go like, 'of course if you show flexibility for Mr. Su, we will also show flexibility for the Garretts.'

I think what has taken place so far seems to indicate that the Chinese would want to do a swap.

But, of course, at this stage there is no way that we can do that. For Canada, rule of law is very important. We have principles and we have no other choice but to go through the extradition process for Mrs. Meng Wanzhou.

Would China do this if Mr. Schellenberg were an American citizen?

I don't think so because, in fact, if you look at the situation now it's obvious that the the problem that China has is with the United States and it's this commercial war, and what I would call this containment strategy that is being pursued by the Americans.

But, you know, the U.S. is a superpower and China does not dare to take any measures and so they turn around and it's easy for them to kick us and, frankly, it's bullying that they are doing against Canada.

We have sought the support of friendly countries, and we have had quite a bit of support, and it's unprecedented that something like this happened.

This took the Chinese by surprise and there were comments in the Chinese press this week to try to dismiss this but for sure it has been noted in Beijing.

IMF cuts forecast for 2019 growth in Canada, world

The International Monetary Fund has cut its forecast for world economic growth this year, citing heightened trade tensions and rising U.S. interest rates.

The IMF said Monday that it expects global growth this year of 3.5 per cent, down from 3.7 per cent in 2018 and from the 3.7 per cent it had forecast for 2019 back in October.

Unveiling its forecasts at the World Economic Forum in Davos, Switzerland, the fund left its prediction for U.S. growth this year unchanged at 2.5 per cent.

For Canada, the IMF's estimate for growth in 2019 was 1.9 per cent, down from a forecast in October for growth of 2.0 per cent.

The IMF's view is more positive than an assessment by the Bank of Canada issued Jan. 9. The central bank forecast growth of 1.7 per cent this year, down from its October prediction of 2.1 per cent.

The IMF expects the Chinese economy - the world's second biggest - to grow 6.2 per cent this year, down from 6.6 per cent in 2018 and the slowest since 1990.

Chinese growth slowing



China announced Monday its GDP had expanded by 6.6 per cent in 2018, down from 2017's 6.9 per cent. Growth in the three months ending in December dipped to 6.4 per cent - the lowest quarterly level since the 2008 global crisis - from the previous quarter's 6.5 per cent.

Chinese growth helped kickstart the world's economy after the 2008 financial crisis and economists fear the slowdown will put a drag on global growth.

The Chinese economy is transitioning from one based on trade to one driven by domestic consumption, says Fotios Raptis, senior economist at TD Bank. He said the dramatic slowdown confirmed today was expected, in part because of weaker infrastructure spending and the tariff war with the U.S.

"Efforts by policymakers to stimulate economic activity, such as cutting the required reserve ratio in the banking sector and broad tax cuts, have likely

acted to prevent a more dramatic decline," he said in a note to clients. The IMF's growth outlook for the 19 countries that use the euro currency has been reduced to 1.6 per cent from 1.8 per cent.

The World Bank and the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development have also downgraded their world growth forecasts.

Trade tensions create uncertainty

Rising trade tensions pose a major risk to the world economy. Under President Donald Trump the United States has imposed import taxes on steel, aluminum and hundreds of Chinese products, drawing retaliation from China and other U.S. trading partners.

"Higher trade uncertainty will further dampen investment and disrupt global supply chains," said IMF chief economist Gita Gopinath.

Rising interest rates in the U.S. and elsewhere are also pinching emerging-market governments and companies that borrowed heavily when rates were ultra-low in the aftermath of the 2007-2009 Great Recession.

As the debt roll over, those borrowers have to refinance at higher rates. A rising dollar is also making things harder for emerging-market borrowers who took out loans denominated in the U.S. currency.

U.S. faces deadline to extradite Huawei exec from Canada

U.S. authorities are facing a key deadline at the end of the month to formally request the extradition of Huawei executive Meng Wanzhou from Canada to the United States.

On Friday, a spokesperson for Canada's Justice Department said the U.S. had yet to file the required paperwork in the Meng case and stated the Americans have until Jan. 30 to do so. If the U.S. misses the deadline, lawyers with expertise in extradition cases say the door could open for Meng's eventual release.

Canadian police arrested Meng at Vancouver's airport Dec. 1 at the request of American authorities, who are seeking her extradition on fraud allegations. They say she lied to American banks as part of a scheme for Huawei to avoid U.S. sanctions against Iran.

Her arrest has infuriated Beijing and the case is at the centre of an increasingly testy diplomatic dispute between Canada and China. The Chinese government says Meng has done nothing wrong and has demanded her release, warning Canada of severe consequences if it doesn't free her.

Under Canada's extradition law, the U.S. was given 60 days from the date of Meng's arrest to make its formal extradition request.

"The formal request for extradition [including the supporting documents] has not yet been made by the United States," Ian McLeod, a spokesperson for Canada's Justice Department, wrote in an email Thursday.

"They have until Jan. 30, 2019 to submit this request. Canada then has a



further 30 days to determine whether to issue an authority to proceed."

The U.S. Department of Justice declined to say very much about the Meng case except that it's not affected by the partial shutdown of the federal government there. Thousands of federal workers have been sent home without pay because of a budget stalemate between Congress and U.S. President Donald Trump.

"We have no comment other to say that the current operating situation has no impact on our filing preparations," the department's public-affairs office said.

Meng case in 'political stage' Gary Botting, a Vancouver lawyer with significant experience in extradition cases, said recently appointed federal Justice Minister David Lametti would have an obligation to discharge Meng if the U.S. misses the deadline.

"If it hasn't arrived in the 60 days then every journalist in town should be jumping up and down to insist that Meng get discharged according to the act," Botting said in an interview. "That's what the act says... The minister

must discharge them according to the rule."

Meng's case, Botting added, remains in a "political stage" and won't go before the courts - and into the "legal stage" - until Lametti makes the decision to introduce an authority to proceed.

Meng, Huawei's chief financial officer, is out on \$10-million bail and is staying at her Vancouver home. She has been ordered to appear in a Vancouver courtroom on Feb. 6 to fix a date for further proceedings.

Lawyer Donald Bayne, who represented Ottawa professor Hassan Diab as he fought extradition on French terrorism charges for years, said it's not particularly unusual that U.S. authorities had yet to submit the formal request for Meng so late in the 60-day period.

He thinks they'll make the deadline.

"The Americans... having caused all of this so far - would never be able to say with a straight face, 'Yeah, we've decided not to go ahead' or 'Gosh, there was nothing on our case,'" said Bayne, who's based in Ottawa.

Canadians arrested in China

In the days that followed Meng's arrest, China detained two Canadians. Michael Kovrig, a Canadian diplomat on leave, and Michael Spavor, an entrepreneur, were taken in on vague allegations of engaging in activities that have endangered China's national security.

China also sentenced another Canadian, Robert Lloyd Schellenberg, to death in a sudden retrial of his drug-smuggling case. He was originally sentenced in 2016 to a 15-year term, but the court delivered the new sentence after reconsidering his case.

Western analysts believe the arrests and the death sentence are part of an attempt by Beijing to pressure Canada into releasing Meng.

Bayne said he doesn't think Meng's case would end even if the Americans missed their deadline - but comments by Trump might do it.

He noted how last month the U.S. president raised questions about the basis of the extradition request by musing in an interview with Reuters about interfering in Meng's case if it would help him strike a trade deal with China.

Meng's legal team could argue Trump's remarks, which essentially made her a "human bargaining chip," indicated an abuse of process.

On the U.S.-China trade front, the deadline in the Meng case will coincide with high-level negotiations between Washington and Beijing, said the Chinese Ministry of Commerce.

China's Vice-Premier Liu He, the country's economic point person, is scheduled to travel to meet with U.S. Trade Representative Robert Lighthizer in Washington on Jan. 30 and 31 for a round of talks. They will meet as their two countries are locked in a tariff conflict that's rattled the global economy.

Former Liberal candidate accuses Trudeau and Liberal Party of rigging nomination contest in Milton, Ont.

Businessman Azim Rizvee says Prime Minister Justin Trudeau and the Liberal Party preferred to have Olympic champion Adam van Koevorden as their candidate, and "forced" him to withdraw from the nomination contest.

A former Liberal candidate who came within a five percentage point margin of unseating Conservative Deputy Leader Lisa Raitt in the 2015 election is accusing Prime Minister Justin Trudeau and the Liberal Party of manipulating a nomination contest to make way for their preferred candidate, Olympic gold medalist Adam van Koevorden, for the 2019 election.

In a press release, businessman Azim Rizvee said he was "forced" by the party to withdraw from the nomination for Milton, Ont., after Prime Minister Justin Trudeau (Papineau, Que.) personally told him and his wife that Mr. van Koevorden, an Olympic gold medalist in sprint kayaking, is his preferred candidate.

Mr. Rizvee won 40.4 per cent of the



votes in the 2015 election in Milton, losing to Ms. Raitt, who garnered 45.3 per cent of the vote.

Mr. Rizvee said he's holding a press conference at 2pm this afternoon at 1195 Winter Crescent in Milton, Ont. to provide more details about his

experience about the nomination contest with the media.

"Prime Minister Justin Trudeau, personally told me and my wife very aggressively that Adam van Koevorden is his preferred candidate for the Milton riding. I am little worried for you guys

but I will keep pushing Adam van Koevorden. He is a good man and we need him in Ottawa," Mr. Rizvee wrote in the press release. "We felt threatened, harassed and bullied."

The nomination contest is scheduled to take place tomorrow.

In an emailed response to The Hill Times, Braeden Caley, senior director of communications to the Liberal Party, said that the nomination contest will be fair and in accordance with the party's rules.

"Milton has seen exciting growth in Liberal support over the past year, with hundreds of new registered Liberals looking forward to running a campaign focused on Justin Trudeau's positive progress to strengthen the middle class and grow the economy," wrote Mr. Caley in his email.

"Grassroots Liberals will be voting to nominate their 2019 candidate tomorrow, and the nomination process is fully in line with all of the Liberal Party of Canada's national nomination rules."

Mr. Trudeau promised free, fair, and open nominations when he ran for the Liberal leadership in 2013. But since then there have been numerous cases of candidates raising serious questions about the fairness of Liberal nomination contests.

By deadline, the prime minister's office was not available for comment.

Canadian banks are at risk warns hedge fund

One of the top performing US hedge funds is shorting Canadian banks in the belief that a recession is coming.

Crescat Capital says that more than 80% of Canadian companies are not generating enough cash - the highest share in the world - and global macro analyst Tavi Costa told Bloomberg that the big banks will be come off badly.

He said that if monetary conditions were tighter, these companies that are not generating cash would be bankrupt.

The firm returned 41% in its Global Macro Fund in 2018 and 32% in its Long/Short Fund, putting it in among the best performers of last year, which saw the hedge fund industry posting a



4.1% loss.

Costa did not name the banks that the fund has shorted but he did say that the housing market poses a risk to financial institutions, suggesting the largest lenders would be impacted.


"Most of these banks are off their highs and have just started to break down," Costa said.

With a cooling housing market, Costa warns that high levels of household debt make the market - and wider economy - vulnerable to changing conditions.

"China is in the process of reversing its key role as a driver of global economic growth," Costa told Bloomberg. "Countries like Canada and Australia, and their respective housing markets, are the economies most vulnerable in this scenario."

Crescat Capital's CEO Kevin Smith has been talking to Bloomberg TV and repeated the concerns of his analyst.

First High level Inter-Agency meeting on Science Diplomacy

Foreign Minister Shah Mahmood Qureshi inaugurated the first high level Inter Agency meeting on "Science Diplomacy". This initiative was launched in September last year with the designation of a focal point (Science Diplomacy Division) to act as a liaison between national S&T stakeholders and international partners.

Canadian military has no plans to eliminate 'duty to report' sexual misconduct

OTTAWA - Canada's top general is promising better support for victims of military sexual misconduct, but says he will not get rid of a regulation that Canada's auditor general has warned discourages some victims from coming forward.

The "duty to report" regulation compels service members to report any type of inappropriate or criminal behaviour - whether sexual or not - to higher authorities, which begins a formal complaint process.

Military police have previously cited this requirement as having helped increase the number of reported cases of sexual misconduct brought to their attention, particularly from bystanders or other third parties.

However, auditor general Michael Ferguson reported in November that the requirement had contributed to underreporting of sexual misconduct among victims who did not want to trigger formal complaints.

In an interview, defence chief Gen. Jonathan Vance said military officials are looking at ways to ensure victims are better supported and empowered when they or someone else reports misconduct.

"If you're a member of the armed forces and you see a crime, you're



supposed to report it," Vance told The Canadian Press. "We all want this to stop, and one of the ways to stop it is to not turn a blind eye. Failure to report could also be deemed turning a blind eye. And so you can't have it both ways."

Eradicating sexual misconduct has been a top priority for military commanders since a series of devastating reports several years ago uncovered a highly sexualized culture where misbehavior was ignored or hidden.

The auditor general did not specifically call for the regulation to be rescinded, but emphasized the importance of providing adequate support to victims when they do come forward given that some do not do so willingly.

Vance admitted the Forces had fallen short on that count in the past, but said the military is now looking to address those shortfalls and ensure that victims of sexual misconduct don't go through more hardship than they already have.

"Duty-to-report and a bunch of other ways that we've dealt with victims has made that journey from being a victim to recovering too hard," he said. "So we're going to address that."

Exactly how remains to be seen. The military's sexual misconduct response centre is seized with the problem, Vance said, while outside experts are being consulted to determine the best way forward.

The head of the response centre recently revealed that the organization was planning to start providing victims

with case workers who will provide continuous support from the moment an incident is reported to the end of the case.

Vance suggested victims could also be given more power over when a formal complaint is launched after an incident is reported to a commanding officer or using alternate-dispute resolution rather than launching a formal hearing.

"Where the challenge will lie is if there's a potential crime and the police want or need to get involved," he said in reference to the fact military police operate independently of the chain of command. "We're working through that. How do we manage that so the victim is best cared for?"

In addition to the duty to report, the auditor general also flagged concerns with a lack of specialized training for chaplains and military health professionals to support victims.

Most criminal cases took more than seven months to be closed by military police, who were also found to regularly skip procedures - including providing victims with support packages or referring them to assistance.

The audit also found that poor training for all service members had produced only a vague understanding of what constitutes inappropriate behaviour, which actually threatened to undermine military cohesion and esprit de corps.

"I don't consider it negative criticism," Vance said of the overall report. "It basically said to us: 'You've gotten a start. Here's some areas we've found that you need to work on. Keep going.' We think the same thing."

Former Olympic kayaker Adam van Koeverden wins federal Liberal nomination in Milton

Former Olympic kayaker Adam van Koeverden has won the federal Liberal nomination in Milton Sunday.

The Liberal Party made the announcement Sunday evening on Twitter.

The party said in a statement that the "long-time Liberal ... received early support from a broad spectrum of community and business leaders in Milton and spent several weeks knocking on doors and meeting with the families within the riding."

Van Koeverden has won four medals at the Olympics, including gold - the most by any Canadian paddler - as well as two



world championships. He was Canada's flagbearer at the Olympic games in Athens and Beijing.

He will be running against veteran

Conservative MP Lisa Raitt in Milton. Raitt has held the riding since it was first created in 2015 and has been a high profile member of former Prime Minister

Stephen Harper's cabinet. She was appointed the Deputy Leader of the Official Opposition by Conservative Leader Andrew Scheer.

Van Koeverden, 36, announced his intention to run as a Liberal candidate last October.

According to a website outlining his candidacy, van Koeverden's campaign will put an emphasis on youth, sport, physical education and healthy communities.

The riding has not been without controversy. The party's 2015 candidate, Azim Rizvee, said that Prime Minister Justin Trudeau pushed him to resign.

"Prime Minister Justin Trudeau told me and my wife very aggressively that Adam van Koeverden is his preferred candidate for the Milton riding," Rizvee said in a statement Saturday. "The Liberal party leadership did not allow me to contest the nomination so that [the] prime minister's preferred candidate, Adam van Koeverden, can be nominated."

Hafeez stars as Pakistan beat South Africa by 5 wickets in first ODI

Imam-ul-Haq and Mohammad Hafeez hit half-centuries as Pakistan cruised to a five-wicket win over South Africa in the first of five matches against Pakistan at St George's Park on Saturday.

Opener Imam hit 86 while Hafeez finished on an unbeaten 71 as Pakistan chased down their 267-run target with five balls to spare.

Earlier, Hashim Amla hit his 27th one-day international century as South Africa made 266 for the loss of two wickets.

Amla (108 not out) shared a second-wicket partnership of 155 with debutant Rassie van der Dussen (93) but the pair were unable to dominate against steady bowling on a slow pitch.

"It was a tough wicket," Amla told SuperSport television as he left the field at the end of the innings. "You have to bid your time. I think it's a good total." Although Pakistan were only able to claim two wickets, they bowled well on a windy day, with captain Sarfraz Ahmed juggling his bowlers in short spells.

Scoring was slow during the middle overs with seamer Hasan Ali and



leg-spinner Shadab Khan bowling particularly well. They took one for 42 and one for 41 respectively in their ten overs.

Amla and Reeza Hendricks (45) put on 82 off 105 balls for the first wicket before Van der Dussen made a slow start in his first one-day international, taking ten balls to score his first run.

But the scoring rate picked up and Van der Dussen hit six fours and three sixes in a 101-ball innings. Amla made his runs off 120 balls with seven fours and a six.

South Africa won the toss and decided to bat in the first one-day international against Pakistan on Saturday. The pitch at St George's Park looked

good for batting, while a strong wind seemed likely to pose a challenge to bowlers and fielders.

"It looks [like] a good wicket and there may be a bit more spin in the second innings," said South African captain Faf du Plessis.

South Africa fielded two new caps in batsman Rassie van der Dussen and fast bowler Duanne Olivier, who was man of the series in a recent Test series between the two countries.

"We are used to playing in wind because we have played in Wellington (New Zealand)," said Pakistan captain Sarfraz Ahmed.

Ahmed said he was determined to make a good start to the series on a ground where Pakistan are unbeaten in three previous matches against South Africa, with two wins and a no-result.

MELBOURNE: Defending champion Roger Federer was stunned by fiery Greek Stefanos Tsitsipas who ended his bid for a record seventh Australian Open Sunday on a day of upsets that also saw second seed Angelique Kerber crash out.

The Swiss master caved in under the energy and pressure of a man 17 years his junior to tumble out 6-7 (11-13), 7-6 (7-3), 7-5, 7-6 (7-5) in the last 16 on Rod Laver Arena.

World No. 2 Kerber was also sensationally bundled out by a woman playing the event for the first time, with American Danielle Collins humiliating the Wimbledon champion 6-0, 6-2 in under an hour.

The man Federer beat in last year's final, sixth seed Marin Cilic, was also sent packing by Spain's Roberto Bautista Agut, who now plays Tsitsipas in the quarter-finals.

Five-time Grand Slam winner Maria Sharapova and fifth seed Sloane Stephens were others to fall, but there was no such drama for a rampant Rafael Nadal who powered into the last eight with a straight sets win over Tomas Berdych.

Federer was gunning for a 21st Grand Slam title but had a battle on his hands from off against the 20-year-old, touted among the new generation of young stars as a future champion.

"I'm the happiest man on Earth right now, I cannot describe it," said the 14th seed, who is the first Greek in history to reach the quarter-finals of a Slam. "I've

been idolising him [Federer] since the age of six. It was a dream come true for me just being on Rod Laver facing him. Winning at the end, I can't describe it."

Wimbledon winner and 2016 champion Kerber, the bookies' favourite along with Serena Williams after defending champion Caroline Wozniacki was ousted early, was no match for Collins, ranked 35 in the world.

Collins is little known after playing much of her tennis in the US college system and was making her debut in the main draw at Melbourne Park. She had never won a Grand Slam match before

"I always say the same when I am back for injury," said the Spaniard. "I don't expect negative or positive things. I just try to do my work every day and just be with [the] right attitude every single day."

He will play world no. 39 Frances Tiafoe for a place in the semi-finals after the young American celebrated his 21st birthday by grinding down Grigor Dimitrov 7-5, 7-6 (8-6), 6-7 (1-7), 7-5.

Hometown hero Ashleigh Barty also made the last eight after mauling past Sharapova and will next meet Petra Kvitova.

Sharapova claimed her biggest scalp since completing a drugs ban in 2017 when she rolled Wozniacki in round three and looked on track to carry the momentum forward.

The 30th seed won the first set but then fell to pieces, eventually succumbing 4-6, 6-1, 6-4.

"I knew I had to keep chipping away - in a sense, trust the work we've done. I know that I can match it with the best," said Barty, seeded 15.

Next up for the diminutive 22-year-old is Kvitova, who beat Barty in the final of the warm-up Sydney International this month.

People make mistakes: Sourav Ganguly defends Pandya, Rahul

Mumbai: Former Indian cricket team skipper Sourav Ganguly has defended cricketers Hardik Pandya and K.L. Rahul over their "Koffee With Karan" episode controversy, saying people make mistakes but everyone should move on and ensure it doesn't happen again.

Ganguly spoke at the trailer launch of the Hindi film "22 Yards", with the cast members Barun Sobti, Geetika Tyagi and Chaiti Ghoshal and director Mitali Ghoshal here on Wednesday.

Pandya and Rahul were slammed over their sexist comments on "Koffee with Karan". Despite an apology to fans and their own teammates, Pandya and Rahul were suspended by the BCCI and ousted from a three-match ODI series against Australia in Sydney.

Asked if modern day cricketers should be responsible while giving statements on a public platform as a whole lot of youngsters look up to them, Ganguly said: "I haven't watched that episode. I watch 'Comedy Nights with Kapil'. Jokes apart, I feel that you can't generalise that only modern day cricketers should behave responsibly. People make mistakes. Let's not get too far into that."



"I am sure whoever has done it will realise that and come out as a better person. We are all human beings. We are not machines that everything you put in comes out perfect. You have just got to live life and let others live. They are responsible people. They may be role models but they are under pressure all the time to perform. Certain things happen in life and as everyone, we should move on and make sure that it doesn't happen again."

Does he feel modern day cricketers of India aren't responsible in their behaviour as compared to the past generation of cricketers?
Ganguly said: "I feel modern day

cricketers are also responsible, disciplined and obedient. In life, certain things happen and you make some mistakes so, let's not get too far into that. Look at Virat Kohli, he is such a fantastic role model. India is a fortunate country. Every generation produces players who all of us cherish."

He said India has produced great cricketers like Sunil Gavaskar, Sachin Tendulkar and Virat Kohli over the years.

"There was Sunil Gavaskar and when he retired, people thought who is next, then Sachin Tendulkar came and when Tendulkar retired, people again asked who is next then people saw Virat Kohli. So, we are a very fortunate country in terms of sports and a lot of these cricketers are fantastic human beings because they come from very middle class backgrounds and fight their way up."

Bollywood has made films on the life of sports personalities like Milkha Singh, Mahendra Singh Dhoni and now Kabir Khan is making a film on the Indian cricket team's World Cup victory in 1983. If a biopic is made on Ganguly's life, then which actor should play his role?

"It is difficult for me to answer that question because I haven't thought about a biopic on my life. People should first make a biopic of other sports personalities and if people have an interest in my biopic, then we will see."

"I really liked the biopic of Milkha Singh and Mahendra Singh Dhoni. The film on Sachin Tendulkar was a bit different. Now, I have heard that the film on India's 1983 World Cup win is being made. I feel that was a great time for Indian cricket, so I am looking forward to see that film. As far as my biopic is concerned, we will wait and see as at the moment I haven't thought about it."

Asked if he has been approached by ALTBalaji to make a web series on his life, he said: "Is it Miss Ekta Kapoor's production house? Because I am not aware of production houses and if yes, then I have spoken to her but nothing more than that."

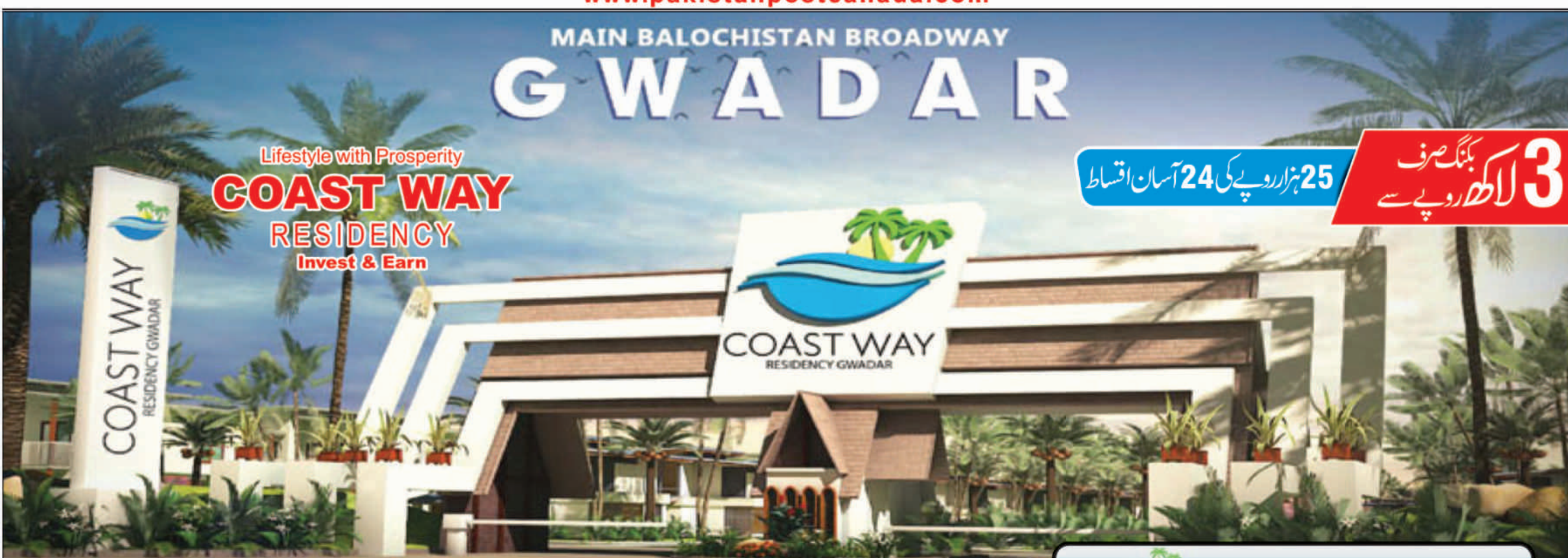
