New \$100M settlement reached in RCMP sexual harassment case

Three years after settling a sexual harassment and discrimination lawsuit with female officers for \$100 million, the RCMP has reached a second settlement - for about another \$100 million - for women who worked for the force in non-policing roles.

The settlement was announced Monday morning by Klein Lawyers LLP, the same Vancouver law firm that handled the first settlement in 2016. The latest pact is subject to approval by a federal court.

Cheryl Tiller, who worked for the force as a stenographer in Yorkton, Sask., and is lead plaintiff, said she was sexually harassed at a retirement party for an RCMP corporal in 2007.

Tiller said a sergeant touched her in a sexual manner while other officers watched.

An emailed statement from the law firm said women who experienced gender or sexual-orientation-based harassment or discrimination working as municipal staff, contractors and volunteers on or after Sept. 16, 1974, might be eligible for compensation.

Compensation for proven claims over the 45-year period would range from \$10,000 to \$222,000 each. There is no cap.

Statistically, the law firm estimates about 1,500 claims will be made to the settlement.

"This settlement is an acknowledgment of the pain experienced by women who were subjected to harassment and sexual assault while working or volunteering



with the RCMP," Angela Bespflug, a Vancouver-based lawyer for the plaintiffs, said in a statement.

"No amount of money can compensate these women for the harms that they've endured, but the settlement gives a voice to their experiences."

Speaking to reporters on Monday, Bespflug said some of the stories she heard working on the case were "horrific."

"We want to thank the plaintiffs for their bravery in commencing this action and sharing their deeply personal stories," the lawyer said, adding her clients' "resilience was humbling."

Asked if there was any resistance to the settlement from the RCMP, Bespflug laughed, and said: "It's always a lot of work to reach a settlement. This case was no different."

Ontario's new Grade 10 careers curriculum to stress financial literacy

TORONTO - Ontario's new career studies curriculum for Grade 10 will include learning about financial literacy, including having students make a plan to fund their first year after high school.

The province's new education minister, Stephen Lecce, unveiled the updated curriculum Tuesday at Toronto's York University.

Lecce says the mandatory course will focus on "monetizable skills" and the jobs of the future, such as those in science, technology, engineering and math.

He says it will also teach students about the workplace implications of social media and how to protect their privacy online.

The new curriculum, which is slated to take effect in September, will also take a deeper look at financial management.

A document laying out the curriculum expectations says students will be asked to develop a budget for their first year after graduation and compare different forms of borrowing to pay for any post-secondary education they plan to seek, such as provincial student loans.

When Canada's legislatures don't sit, we all lose

"I try never to go over there. Because it's sick. It's a sick culture." These words have stayed with me since I met B.C. premier Christy Clark uttered them in 2012, defending her decision to cancel an entire sitting of the legislature.

"All they can think about is government, and there are no real people in Victoria, and you get compared by this inside-the-beltway debate, and it's really unhealthy."

It's an attitude that is fairly pervasive among all governments who attempt to inject a bit of populism into their agendas - that because Parliament or the provincial legislatures are these hives of unreality, what happens there shouldn't matter to ordinary people. This is bolstered by elected representatives at both the federal and provincial levels who talk about how busy they are working in their constituencies, and in recent years, there has been pressure to make the jobs of our elected representatives more "family-friendly," which has curtailed sitting hours as well as whole sitting days - so much so that several provinces have eliminated Friday sittings altogether. MPs in Ottawa are continually attempting to do this, too, without quite as much success.

But all of this ignores the fact that under our system of government, our representatives' jobs are not to be a



constituency outreach worker, but rather, to hold the government - meaning cabinet - to account, and they do that by controlling the public purse.

So while it may not be a surprise, given the trends in Canadian politics, the numbers are stark, all the same: a Globe and Mail data-dive found that provincial legislatures are, on the whole, sitting far less over the past decade than they used to, with a few notable exceptions, including Ontario and Quebec.

And it's more than just elected officials trying to spend more time at home that is causing shorter sitting periods, but rather a certain amount of centralization of power that is making legislatures - particularly in provinces with majority governments - feel a bit superfluous to the cause of democracy.

It's not just about Question Period, which is still an important public vehicle of accountability, even if it has degenerated over time into an opportunity for parties to gather video clips for social media. Yes, governments would like to limit their exposure to those bright lights as much as possible, but it's also about MP and MPP/MLA/AMM/MLA/NDAs (depending on how each province styles their representatives) doing the work of scrutinizing the estimates and the public accounts - most especially backbenchers who aren't in cabinet. They are all supposed to be playing an accountability function, but many no longer do.

A big culprit in the general decline of sittings is the way in which political leadership has become so centralized that a handful of individuals in the premier's office have seemingly been allowed to run a whole province. When is your modus operandi, why would you want to risk having a bunch of elected officials messing things up for you?

In provinces with a majority government, it can mean essentially

reducing the legislature to a rubber stamp - particularly as many provinces don't have robust committees that do independent work. Other provinces have put backbenchers onto cabinet committees, which co-opts them from doing any of the accountability functions they are supposed to be doing - that is, if they have any backbenchers at all, as some provinces are smart enough that the entire government caucus is in cabinet and therefore bound by solidarity.

In a way, Ms. Clark is right when she talks about the sick culture, but it's not the one she thinks it is. Rather, the ways in which we run leadership contests in Canada have followed out political parties so much that they are largely now personality cults for party leaders, with the other elected representatives that make up caucus expected to toe that leader's line without question.

When your caucus no longer has any actual sense of autonomy or ability to hold their leaders to account, because they have been given the "democratic legitimacy" of a membership vote, it makes the work of being in the legislature much less meaningful because all of the strings are pulled from the leader's office.

It matters when legislatures don't sit because the whole point of a parliament is to hold government to account. But as with so many of the current ills in Canadian politics, it boils down to how party leaders are chosen, which has led to this erosion of accountability and centralization of power. Change that, and make the jobs of all of our elected representatives meaningful again, and it will be more than just the opposition howling when the sitting days are cut short.

Majority of Canadians against accepting more refugees, poll suggests

A pre-election survey conducted for CBC News suggests Canadians are divided on immigration, with clear limits on the kind of migration they find acceptable.

The government groups immigrants into three categories: economic, which are skilled workers and businesspeople, along with their partners and dependants; family reunification; and refugees or those admitted under humanitarian or compassionate grounds.

More than three-quarters (76 per cent) of respondents to a survey by Public Square Research and Manu/Blue agreed that Canada should do more to encourage skilled labourers to immigrate to the country, while 57 per cent said Canada should not accept more refugees.

The results come as no surprise to immigration experts and advocates, who point to a negative shift in tone on migration around the world, especially when it comes to refugees. They say that trend is stoked by media coverage in Canada of asylum seekers crossing the country's border with the U.S.

'Dramatic decline' in welcoming of refugees

One organization in Manitoba says it is seeing that shift first-hand. "There's been a dramatic decline in the acceptance and the welcoming, specifically of refugees," said Dorota Blumczynska, executive director of the Immigrant and Refugee Community Organization of Manitoba. Her family came as privately sponsored refugees to Canada nearly three decades ago.

She says that decline has made some newcomers anxious. "There is an internal struggle that I have really witnessed around whether or not people want to identify as refugees," she added.

Alenayahu Beyene, whose family arrived in Canada about 25 years ago, said he has found people in Canada to be welcoming and was surprised by the result of the poll.

"Maybe they don't understand why we came here," said the 55-year-old who fled Ethiopia about 25 years ago and spent most of the years since in a refugee camp in Sudan. "Nobody wants to be a refugee. Somebody would just go into refugee."

Christina Clark-Kazak, a University of Ottawa professor who specializes in refugees and immigration, said the

survey results reflect a long-standing tradition of Canadian immigration policy being centred around labour market needs. Under both Conservative and Liberal governments over the past decade, economic immigrants have made up between 53 and 63 per cent of immigrants each year, according to Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) data.

"The problem with a lot of the immigration policy is we think about individuals in isolation, and we think about them only as economic actors," she said.

Refugees, she added, are often seen as a "nice-to-have" by policy-makers but not a priority.

The survey polled 4,500 adults online from among those who are registered with the Manu/Blue panel. Respondents were asked to agree or disagree with the following statements:

"Canada is doing a good job of keeping criminals and suspected criminals out of the country."

Canada. "Canada should be doing more to encourage skilled labour to immigrate to Canada."

"Illegal immigration is becoming a serious problem in Canada."

In another section, they were asked to select one of the following:

"Too many immigrants are visible minorities."

"About right number of immigrants are visible minorities."

"Not enough immigrants are visible minorities."

"I don't care about the ethnic makeup of immigrants."

Of the 3,112 people who answered the above:

"64 per cent said illegal immigration is becoming a serious problem."

"56 per cent said that accepting too many immigrants will change Canada."

"24 per cent said too many immigrants are visible minorities."

"This veneer of tolerance"

"I think it is reflective that there is this sort of thin veneer of tolerance, but underneath there is a lot of racism that still exists in Canada," said Clark-Kazak.

She said the Canadian context is also influenced by language coming out of the U.S. from a president she sees as anti-refugee, anti-immigration and anti-Islam. That discourse, she said, is seeping into both the political sphere and everyday life.

Feds announce \$5.75M in funding for housing retrofits in Toronto and Hamilton



The federal government has announced \$5.75 million in grants and loans to support "deep energy retrofits" in four residential buildings in Toronto and Hamilton.

Officials say the project, which is being funded through the Federation of Canadian Municipalities' Green Municipal Fund, will retrofit heating, cooling and lighting systems alongside other measures to reduce energy and water waste.

"I think we're all in agreement of why we need to improve the energy efficiency of buildings - it's the biggest, it's the fastest, it's the cheapest way to fight climate change," said Julia Langer, CEO of The Atmospheric Fund, which is leading the project.

According to a news release, the retrofits will reduce energy consumption by 40 per cent in these buildings, as well as cut energy bills

for residents. The project includes measures like replacing baseboard heaters and window air conditioning units with all-in-one, energy efficient units, air sealing and weatherization on windows and doors, as well as the installation of solar panels and ground and air source heat pumps.

The city says these upgrades are in line with Toronto's "TransformTO Climate Action Strategy," which includes a push to reduce greenhouse

gas emissions in the city by 80 per cent by 2050.

"We're doing so much in the Toronto Community Housing communities," said Mayor John Tory at Monday morning's announcement.

"It's never going to be enough, but [this is] a huge step forward."

"When you have homes and buildings accounting for 45 per cent of our greenhouse gas emissions, then you just know that initiatives like this one today - and then after that neighbourhood by neighbourhood, building by building across the city - [are] going to be something that is very important for the environment, but also very important for people."

The buildings that will be renovated include one rental apartment building, one condo building and two low-income social housing buildings, representing nearly 800 households. Here's where they are located:

Imad Wasim dismisses rumours of grouping within cricket team

All-rounder Imad Wasim on Monday dismissed rumours of grouping within the Pakistani cricket team, also saying that the players had decided to "avoid the media" after the humiliating defeat in a World Cup group-stage match against India.

Wasim was addressing a press conference in Islamabad along with teammate Shahab Khan a day after skipper Sarfaraz Ahmed spoke to the media in Karachi.

The players returned to the country from the United Kingdom after Pakistan failed to qualify for the semifinals due to net run-rate difference with New Zealand for both the teams earned 11 points each from nine league matches.

The all-rounder, in the press conference today, said that had there been any grouping within the team, he would not have played.

"All of us play for Pakistan," he declared and added: "I've known Sarfaraz for 15 years, he is not that type of a person. There have never been any disagreements or disputes. On field, if there are minor

disagreements or if the captain says something, we should take it as a player."

Wasim told reporters that Ahmed had called a team meeting after the humiliating defeat in a World Cup group-stage match against India.

"The meeting was also a turning point for us [...] you know there were a lot of rumours circulating in the media about grouping in the team but it was nothing like that. So when we had that meeting, he [Ahmed] told us to avoid media reports, give our 100 per cent and produce results that are in favour of Pakistan," he told reporters.

Wasim also condemned the bashing that the players received at the hands of the media and public, saying that "criticism over personal issues is not okay."

"When we play against India, it seems like we have gone to [fight] a war," he said. "It is a game, and winning and losing is part of a game."

"We were criticised a lot, which is fine. Criticism over [the way we

played] cricket is fine. But criticism over personal issues is not fine. This does not happen anywhere in the world except in our country."

When asked if he blamed lack for Pakistan's failure to qualify for the semifinals despite four wins under their belt, Wasim said: "I don't believe in luck, we should make our own destiny. We should work hard. Results is in our hands - the things that are controllable are in our hands."

Khan said that even though the team's performance had improved drastically after the dismal defeat from West Indies, Pakistan could not increase their net run rate because the pitches did not allow high-scoring.

US win women's football World Cup

LYON (France). The United States won a record-extending fourth women's football World Cup title with a 2-0 victory over the Netherlands on Sunday as second-half goals from Megan Rapinoe and Rose Lavelle confirmed their status as the leading power in the women's game.

The defending champions struggled to gain dominance for an hour before a Rapinoe penalty, her sixth goal of the tournament, broke the deadlock and a fine individual effort from Lavelle in the 69th minute put the outcome beyond doubt.

The Dutch, who are the European champions, ran out of steam after Rapinoe opened the scoring in the 61st minute, having done more than any team to frustrate the Americans.

A perfect occasion for Rapinoe, whose outspoken views have been prominent especially on the pay disparity between men and women players, was capped when FIFA chief Gianni Infantino was greeted with chants of 'equal pay, equal pay' by American fans.

At 34, Rapinoe is unlikely to be back on this stage in four years' time, but it is hard to imagine her walking away from the battles she has led



With the US Soccer Federation and world governing body FIFA over fair terms for the women's game.

However, amidst the firework celebrations after the final whistle, Rapinoe's thoughts were on her team's fight for the second world title after the 2015 victory in Canada. "It's like history. I don't know how to feel right now. It is ridiculous," said Rapinoe.

"We're crazy that's what makes us special. We just have no quit in us. We're so tight. We will do anything to win."

Argentina's Lionel Messi rues corruption, poor refereeing after receiving red card v Chile

Sao Paulo (Brazil): Lionel Messi hit out at "corruption and referees" at the Copa America after he was harshly sent off as Argentina secured third place with a 2-1 victory over Chile on Saturday.

Five-time encounter In a rivalry and frustration match, five-time Ballon d'Or winner Messi and Chile captain Gary Medel were given their marching orders eight minutes from half-time after tangling on the goal line. Television replays of the incident suggested Messi had done little wrong. "Corruption and the referees are preventing people from enjoying the football and they're ruining a bit," said the global star.

Medel had already been ejected by the refereeing during Argentina's 2-0 semi-final loss against Brazil, claiming the hosts were getting preferential treatment from South American football's governing body CONMEBOL. Saturday's match will be remembered for the double sending-off. In what seemed an innocuous clash, a frustrated Messi showed Medel in the back.

Medel responded by chest-bumping Messi twice in an incident that probably merited no more than a single yellow card for the Chilean. Incredibly, Panagariou referee Mario Diaz de Vivar showed the two captains the red card. "Medel always goes to the limit, but it wasn't a red card for either of us. He (the referee) could have consulted VAR," said Messi.

Medel also took aim at hosts Brazil. "I think there's no doubt that Brazil is going to be champions. The Copa is weighted towards Brazil and hopefully VAR and the referees will have nothing to look at in the final and Peru can compete, because they have the team to do so," he said.

'Days following defeat to India were very tough for team': Sarfaraz speaks after return from World Cup

Pakistan skipper Sarfaraz Ahmed, who returned early morning on Sunday following his return from World Cup after participating in the 2019 ICC World Cup, held a press conference in Karachi.

Pakistan failed to qualify for the semifinals on net run-rate difference with New Zealand after both the teams earned 11 points each from nine league matches.

The skipper said that the team had realised the issue of run rate after its first match of the World Cup tournament - in which West Indies dismissed Pakistan for a disappointing 105 - and later tried to win matches with good margins but the pitches were not favourable.

I discussed everything I had observed during the first five matches, all that we were doing wrong, and all the players responded well and gave their feedback."

"The team then performed very well in the remaining four matches. All players, juniors as well as seniors, played their part and I am happy with them as a captain," said Sarfaraz, also praising the coach and the management for tackling the players

after the defeat to India.

"As far as Shaohib [Malik] is concerned, unfortunately, he was not a part of the final match because we tried to go with a winning combination. He was given a farewell by the team and our best wishes are wish him."

"Now, we will take a break for the next 20 days and then make a new return."

When asked about his demeanour during the first five matches and whether he was under pressure from anyone, Sarfaraz said there was no such pressure from either coach Mickey Arthur or chief selector Inzamam-ul-Haq.

He added that he was not giving up his captaincy but clarified that the final decision would be taken by the Pakistan Cricket Board.

When asked if he had a say in the team selection, he said: "The team was constituted by consensus."
