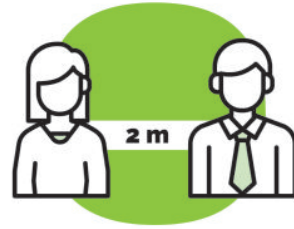

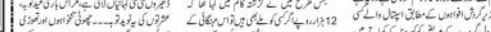

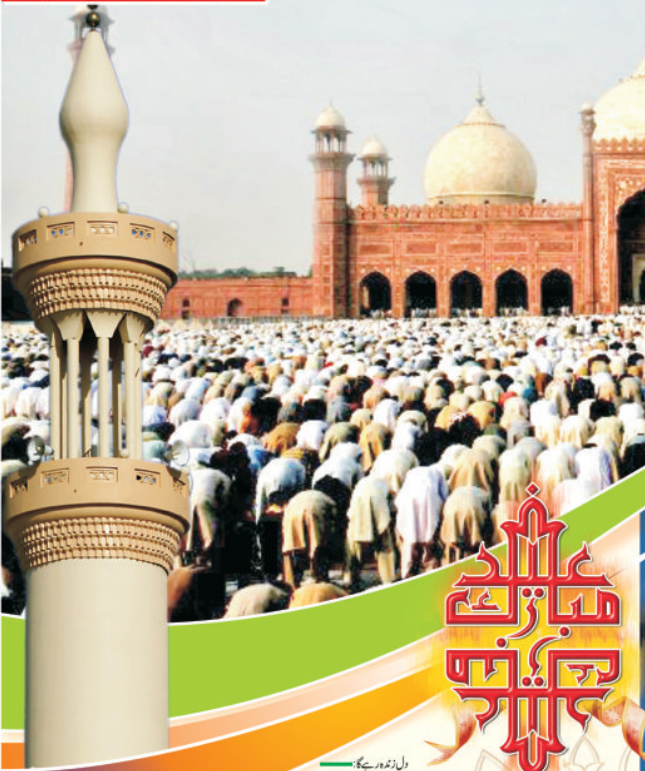

### COVID-19 shutdown affects nearly 2.2 million workers in Ontario, watchdog says

TORONTO — About one in three workers in Ontario has been affected by the economic shutdown caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, the province's fiscal watchdog said recently, warning that the impacts will be more profound the longer business closures continue.

Financial Accountability Officer (FAO) Peter Welton released the finding in a new report on job losses in Ontario since the crisis began.

In all, 2.2 million people have been affected by the shutdown: an estimated 1.1 million workers in the province have lost their jobs, and another 1.1 million have seen their hours sharply reduced.

"It's awful," Welton said. "But it's not surprising, really. This is different than the typical recession. This is a recession where the economy was effectively shut off by the government."

According to Statistics Canada, Ontario lost 689,200 jobs in April, bringing its employment down to the lowest level since 2009. The province's unemployment rate climbed to 11.3 per cent, the highest it has been since 1993.

The FAO report found that since February, temporary worker job losses were occurring at twice the rate of permanent employees — 28 per cent compared to approximately 15 per cent. Nearly 87 per cent of the job losses between February and April came in the private sector.

The report also shows that job losses were largest among women. The FAO said 577,200 women lost

their jobs between February and April, compared to 514,800 men.

The job losses came across all industrial sectors, but those that are public-facing or require close contact suffered significantly. The report said wholesalers and retailers lost 230,900 jobs while accommodation and food services lost 215,800.

The report also notes some reason for optimism, however: the province's economy could experience a sharp bounce back provided COVID-19 cases don't flare up and cause a second lockdown.

But the dangers of that scenario for the economy are also troubling, Welton said.

"Anything that delays a reopening of the economy will have more lasting economic impacts," he said. "The longer people go without work, the longer businesses go without cash flow, they become more in danger of shutting down permanently. So these are the sorts of things that hopefully can be avoided."

The report came a day after the province unveiled its plan to start to reopen more parts of the economy.

Premier Doug Ford announced his government was lifting restrictions on things like retail stores, tennis courts, surgeries and dog grooming.

Asked if a targeted stimulus package was coming for small businesses, Ford pointed to the federal provincial relief program and a federal loan program currently available.

"I think we've done quite a bit," he said. "Do I wish we could do more? Yes, I wish we could do more. But it goes back to, we just don't have the money."

Green party leader Mike Schreiner said the FAO report highlights the need for the government to take urgent action to save small businesses.

Schreiner said the Progressive Conservatives should freeze commercial rent evictions until the end of the pandemic and provide grants of up to \$5,000 to help with rent, utilities and compliance with public health measures.

"With one in three jobs in this province directly affected by the virus, the vulnerability of our economy and social safety net has been laid bare," he said in a statement. "We must focus on immediate help for small businesses to prevent job losses and maintain the vibrancy of our downtowns and neighbourhoods."

NDP economic growth critic Catherine Fife said the report shows government supports for business have "missed the mark."

"The Ford government needs to stop passing the buck to the federal government," she said. "Ford needs to step up to offer real financial supports to workers and small businesses in Ontario, especially women, so they can get through the worst of this crisis and begin to re-build our economy once the pandemic is over."

Liberal finance critic Mitzi Hunter said the government must step up and help vulnerable workers and small businesses.

### Ontario's hospitals are filling up, hampering the resumption of surgeries

Although hospitals around Ontario are now allowed to resume non-emergency surgeries, many of them can't, either because they're too full or don't have enough protective equipment.

Nearly all scheduled surgeries — including cancer surgeries, heart operations, organ transplants and hip replacements — have been postponed under a provincial order issued in March. The goal was to reduce the demands on hospitals and clear space for a feared wave of COVID-19 patients.

The government announced last week that those surgeries (often called elective to distinguish them from emergency surgeries) could resume. But this can happen only in hospitals that meet certain criteria.

Two criteria that are crucial:

"The hospital's occupancy rate must be no higher than 85 per cent."

"The hospital must have a 30-day supply of personal protective equipment (PPE), such as masks, gowns and gloves."

"A large minority of hospitals" do not qualify, said Anthony Dale, president and CEO of the Ontario Hospital Association.

"I know of hospitals already approaching 100 per cent occupancy," Dale said in an interview Friday.

"Why are we allowing hospital occupancy to rise again to very high levels?" he asked, adding that he is "extremely concerned that we're sleepwalking into a situation that we can prevent if we take action now."

Dozens of hospitals are currently registering occupancy rates above the 85 per cent mark, according to the association.

"Clearly this is a risky situation," Dale said. "We have to be serious about the fact that the second wave [of the pandemic] is coming and we need to be prepared."

He is calling on the province to find more space outside of hospital for

patients who don't need acute-care beds and to "redouble its efforts" in helping hospitals obtain PPE.

CBC News asked Health Minister Christine Elliott during a news conference Friday what the province would do to assist.

"There are a number of issues that need to be answered by each individual hospital before they're able to resume scheduled procedures," Elliott said, adding that several thousand surgeries have been delayed.

She said she knows that waiting is "extremely difficult" for people. "We want to start those procedures as soon as possible."

The province "is continuing to work with hospitals to ensure a responsible and measured approach to ramping up scheduled surgeries," added Elliott's manager of media relations, Hsley Charan, in a follow-up email on Friday.

The evidence from hospitals points to two main reasons why occupancy rates are creeping upward.

Emergency departments had witnessed a sharp drop in traffic after the pandemic was declared in March, likely heeding the advice to stay away from hospitals except in the most urgent cases. In recent weeks, people have resumed coming to the ER for medical issues unrelated to COVID-19.

Meanwhile, the novel coronavirus outbreaks that made long-term care homes inaccessible, combined with limits on the availability of home care during the pandemic, mean that fewer patients are being discharged from hospital than are being admitted.

## Ontario sees highest new COVID-19 case count in 2 weeks, testing falls short again

Ontario reported 441 additional cases of COVID-19 on Friday, a third straight day of increasing new daily cases after the province officially entered its first phase of reopening earlier this week.

The new cases - the most on a single day since May 8 - bring the total number of confirmed cases of the illness in the province to 24,628. Of those, 18,767, are resolved. The five-day rolling average of new cases has been trending upward for the last 10 days, after a steady three-week decline.

The two-week high comes as warmer weather arrives in Ontario and just days after the official start of the province's reopening, raising questions about how the government might reinstate lockdown measures if needed.

Asked about that during his daily COVID-19 briefing Friday, Premier Doug Ford said it's a fine line.

"Let's see where we go on this," he said. "We're seeing some peaks and valleys but hopefully the trend goes down because I know the last few days, it's gone up and it's concerning."

Ontario's Chief Medical Officer of Health, Dr. David Williams, was asked Friday if he thought Mother's Day may have played a role in the resurgences.

Williams responded by saying he didn't think Mother's Day itself was a factor but that people may have been more "casual" over the last few weekends than he would have liked.

Just hours later, at a new public health official suggested otherwise.

"Our analysis thus far suggests that people may have acquired the virus during recent events where people traditionally spend time with their families, but at least one public health official suggested otherwise."

"We need to keep monitoring our data to see if events like these or increased mixing of people related to reopening is creating more COVID-19 transmission in our province."

Meanwhile, the number of tests processed by Ontario's network of labs yesterday was 11,276, still short of its own benchmark of 16,000 per day. It's the fifth straight day that the province has failed to meet its target, let alone its capacity of 20,000. The backlog of tests waiting to be processed grew to 5,516.

With criticism mounting about the



Need for more testing in Ontario, Ford appealed to anyone with symptoms Friday to visit a COVID-19 assessment centre.

The premier also said testing will be re-done in long-term care homes over the weekend as well as in retirement homes, and that testing could roll out to truckers and factory workers starting next week.

"I'm just on these numbers constantly, pushing the system," Ford said.

Ontario Health Minister Christine Elliott was asked Friday about the possibility of testing children when the province gets closer to reopening schools. Elliott responded that could in fact happen but would require the permission of a parent or guardian, and would have to be conducted by properly trained health-care workers.

Also announced Friday was a new tool grant program for apprentices and a so-called virtual action centre to support laid off and unemployed hospital workers, which will provide up to 7,000 workers with access to online mental health support and skills training.

The government says it is also forgiving more than \$10 million in outstanding loans owed by about 19,000 apprentices for tools, equipment, clothing and other items - about \$495 each.

Community spread responsible for 1/3 of cases

Some 34.4 per cent of confirmed cases are known to have spread through community transmission, according to the Ministry of Health, while "information is pending" for another 31 per cent.

The province has said it is currently meeting its goal of contact tracing 92 per cent of new daily cases within 24 hours. In his daily address this

morning, Prime Minister Justin Trudeau said that federal employees are assisting Ontario with that effort.

Ford said Friday the province is looking for an appropriate app for Ontarians to download to their phones to help work with contact tracing, but said privacy would be key if the province goes that route.

The Greater Toronto Area continues to account for a majority of cases, 63.9 per cent, in Ontario. Toronto Public Health announced today that it is partnering with the Registered Nurses' Association of Ontario to ramp up its contact tracing efforts locally.

Some 30.4 per cent of total confirmed cases in the province have been in people aged 40-59. The 20-39 demographic makes up 24.8 per cent of all cases. People aged 60-79 and over 80 account for 20.9 per cent and 20.8 percent, respectively.

Meanwhile, Ontario's official death toll increased by 28 to 2,021. But data compiled directly from regional public health units puts the current toll at least 2,113.

Nearly 77 per cent of deaths were residents in long-term care homes, CBC News has found.

Province considering mobile testing Ford said Friday that Ontario will be rolling out an advertising campaign encouraging people to get tested, particularly in areas with higher concentrations of COVID-19 cases.

The province is also considering mobile testing options in areas where infections are deemed to be higher. Associate Medical Officer of Health Dr. Barbara Yaffe said.

Meanwhile, Windsor-Essex County Health Unit said it will start random spot testing in the community with the help of local paramedics, including drive-thru and trailer-based testing at different locations.

## Ontario is reporting 460 new cases of COVID-19, 25 more deaths

The number of new COVID-19 cases continues to rise in Ontario, with more than 400 additional cases confirmed on Saturday.

The province's epidemiological summary released Saturday, which provides data from the previous day, confirmed that there were 460 new cases of the virus on Saturday, up from the 412 reported on Friday and the 441 confirmed on Thursday.

It is the highest number of cases reported since May 7, when 477 new cases of COVID-19 were confirmed.

There are now 25,500 lab-confirmed cases of the virus in Ontario.

An additional 25 deaths have also been reported in Ontario, bringing the total number of virus-related deaths in the province to 2,073.

The number of people who have recovered from COVID-19 now sits at 19,477.

The uptick in cases comes less than a week after the province launched the first stage of its plan to reopen businesses in Ontario, including additional retail stores.

Premier Doug Ford has suggested that he will not "hesitate" to roll things back if cases continue to rise.

The province saw positive signs of declining case growth at the beginning of this month when the daily case count dipped down to 294 on May 9.

But Ontario has not seen the number of new cases in a single day drop below 300 since that date.

The province has also seen a decline in the number of tests completed each day.

Despite having the capacity to process approximately 20,000 tests per day, only 11,383 tests were conducted on Saturday.

Premier Doug Ford has vowed to ramp up testing in the province.

Speaking at Queen's Park on Sunday, Ford said a "detailed testing strategy" that targets "various sectors and hot spots" around Ontario will be rolled out to the public next week.

"The only way we can get those testing members up, the only way we can get those numbers where they need to be, is for everyone who feels they need it, to get a test."

# New U.K. tariff list ramps up urgency of Canada-U.K. trade talks

The United Kingdom has revised its global tariff strategy, laying out for Canada and other trading partners the rates that will apply to their exports as of Jan. 1, 2021 - and in the process, setting out Britain's starting position for future bilateral trade talks.

The new list published Tuesday replaces a temporary regime announced a year ago that would have cut tariffs on nearly all (an estimated 95 per cent) of what the U.K. imports - a hastily-developed scheme designed to cushion the blow to British consumers of a sudden no-deal Brexit that, in March of 2019, appeared possible.

Under the new regime, Most Favoured Nation (MFN) tariff rates higher than zero will apply to about half of the products imported by the U.K. from around the world, or about 60 per cent of the value of its global trade, once it completes its transition out of the European Union trading bloc.

The U.K. continues to negotiate the final terms of this deal.

Many trading partners, Canada included, want clarity on exactly how future trade between the EU and its former member will work before proceeding with their own bilateral talks with the U.K.

Canada has had preferential trading terms with the U.K., its third-biggest export market, under its Comprehensive Economic and Trade Agreement (CETA) with the EU.

The CETA will continue to apply until the end of this year, but beyond that, the terms of Canada-U.K. trade are uncertain.

"We've always paid particular attention to what is happening in the U.K., and of course they are in discussions with the European Union on their agreement," International Trade Minister Mary Ng told CBC News Tuesday.

"We want to make sure that any negotiations are in the interests of [and benefit] our Canadian exporters," she said, adding that the U.K. is a "key trading partner" and the Canadian government expects to have more to say in the days to come.

What she expects if Canada has no deal Tuesday's tariff list adds more certainty to key industries' preparations for the end of the year, when they begin to trade with Britain as an independent partner.

The British government considers its new list a simplified and more liberal version of the European Union's



MFN rates, which set out the tariffs that apply when World Trade Organization members trade with each other.

Canada has enjoyed better access to the EU market than that since September 2017, when the CETA took effect.

At first glance, the tariffs on many of Canada's essential natural resource exports to the U.K. - gold, diamonds, uranium, other energy exports - remain at zero or extremely low.

In fact, none of Canada's top 25 exports to the U.K. appear to face steep new tariffs.

But some of Canada's hard-fought gains in the CETA would be lost. For example, tariffs on popular Canadian seafood products, cut to zero under CETA, would be re-applied in the U.K. market, according to the list.

The U.K. is maintaining tariffs on lamb, beef and poultry to protect its domestic farmers.

It's also maintaining its ten per cent tariff on imported cars, something that was cut under the CETA.

In general, the new list aims to reduce tariffs on inputs for British supply chains, so it does not deal a blow to the manufacturing sector in this already-uncertain Brexit period.

It has cut tariffs on identifiable consumer products that may come from Canada in the future, like Christmas trees. It also cut tariffs on over 100 products that support a green economy, from LED lamps to bicycle tires.

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the U.K. became one of several countries that also have cut tariffs temporarily on essential medical products and supplies.

Analysis continues on all sides to determine what the overall impact on Canada-U.K. trade would be if a bilateral trade agreement is not

concluded between now and Jan. 1.

Build on CETA, or replace it? Both sides say they want to keep trading on preferential terms. That means Canada and the U.K. have two options in the coming months.

They could agree to "roll over" the terms of the CETA and come to an understanding on how it might continue to apply to trade between the two countries, with some minor adjustments. Beyond its preferential tariff rates, the 2017 CETA deal also removed other non-tariff barriers to trade and set out common standards that both sides may want to preserve.

The two sides also might opt to start from scratch and negotiate an entirely new "bespoke" arrangement between themselves, reflecting the unique aspects of their trading relationship separate from the EU priorities that drove the CETA talks.

Negotiations toward this latter option could take longer and become more complicated - at a time when British negotiators already are being stretched thin by multiple trade negotiations fundamental to the U.K.'s economic future.

Even though talks could not officially start until Brexit was complete, Canada was in discussions with the U.K. about rolling over the terms of the CETA. The two sides had nearly reached an agreement in early 2019 when Canada was caught off-guard by Britain's sudden move to cut most of its tariffs to zero.

The Canadian government then stepped back from the talks, uncertain it wanted to continue to offer the same concessions to the U.K. if, in fact, the entire world was about to have access to the same liberalized tariffs.

Since then, opinions have varied on the urgency of negotiating with the U.K. Opposition Leader Andrew Scheer once said he'd have been "eager to sign" and encouraged the Trudeau government to prioritize a deal.

# New Online Tax Filing Program and Virtual Coaching Will Empower Those Who Need It Most

TORONTO, (CNW) - Due to COVID-19, thousands of low-income Canadians who would normally prepare their taxes through Community Volunteer Income Tax Program (CVITP) clinics saw their appointments cancelled, leaving many of Canada's most vulnerable people in need of a way to file their taxes.

As the tax deadline for individuals fast approaches on June 1st, WoodGreen has teamed up with Prosper Canada, Intuit Canada and the Intuit Financial Freedom Foundation to launch a pilot program that will allow clinic users to learn to prepare their own taxes through their mobile devices and computers. Coaching, mentoring and more general support from trained volunteers will be made available by phone or video conference. The pilot program will be offered to clients of WoodGreen's Financial Empowerment Program. This solution is possible due to a recent decision by Canada Revenue Agency to allow tax clinics to offer services remotely. "Low-income individuals must be able to file their taxes to access the benefits and supports they need - particularly given how their lives have been disrupted by COVID-19," said Steven Vanderherberg, Director of Family Finance and Employment Supports at WoodGreen. "This pilot program will provide many of our clients with an innovative tax filing assistance option, without taking on additional risk of coronavirus exposure. We thank Prosper Canada and the Intuit Financial Freedom Foundation for helping make this possible during this tax year." The Virtual Self-Filing program, which builds on an existing in-person clinic run by WoodGreen and supported by Intuit volunteers, hopes to empower WoodGreen's Toronto-based clients and build their financial confidence by supporting them in learning how to prepare their own tax return.

# 'The second wave will come' and experts say Canada is not prepared

TORONTO - A little over two months ago, there was a tenuous shift in Canada's attitude toward COVID-19.

Almost overnight, what had been thought of as primarily a problem for other parts of the world was suddenly understood to be the greatest public health threat the country had seen in generations.

Many Canadians found themselves caught off-guard, surprised to find out that schools and workplaces were being shut down. Only in the following weeks, as new daily case counts climbed from a couple hundred to more than 1,000, did it become clear how high the toll would have been had life gone on as normal.

All of which raises an important question: Will it happen again? Will Canadians be lulled into complacency by declining numbers of new COVID-19 cases, only to find that a number of new infections, only for another round of lockdowns, lead to a large number of deaths that could have been prevented?

Prime Minister Justin Trudeau announced Thursday that his government expects a second wave of COVID-19 to sweep through the country at some point.

"One of the things we know is that in pandemics, there are usually second waves," he said at his daily press briefing.

"The question that we're very much focused on is that, as that second wave begins, or as we start to see resurgences in a reopened economy, how quickly are we able to contain them and control them?"

Medical experts are also increasingly of the view that a second wave of COVID-19 infections spreading across Canada is a question of when, not if.

"The second wave will come, but how acute it is or how large it rises so it doesn't overwhelm our health-care system needs to be considered," Dr. Sandy Buchman, president of the Canadian Medical Association, told CTV News Channel on Thursday.

That was the thinking behind the lockdown-like measures imposed in March. By severely reducing the amount of contact most Canadians had with others, and therefore curtailing the ability of the novel



coronavirus to spread widely, they hoped to limit the critically ill COVID-19 patient load to a number that could be cared for within the existing capacity of the health-care system.

It worked. Hospitals and intensive care units were not overloaded here to the extent they were in many other countries.

But now, as public-gathering limits are increased and other COVID-19-inspired restrictions are relaxed, experts are warning that there is not enough information available to prove that returning to some degree of normalcy is safe - or to alert us to the arrival of a second wave.

"We need to gather more information, we need to do adequate testing in our communities, we have to do more contact tracing, and ultimately we have to do serologic testing," Buchman said.

Buchman brought the same message to the Senate's Standing Committee of Social Affairs, Science and Technology on Wednesday, saying that Canada is "not fully prepared for a second wave" and that provinces are "gambling by reopening" without having more testing and tracing programs in place.

"We have insufficient information as to what's out there, and we can't make really good, evidence-informed decisions about opening up," he told senators.

Serologic testing, also known as antibody testing, measures antibodies that appear in the blood after an

infection. It can be used to detect cases of COVID-19 after the fact, even in those who never displayed symptoms, painting a clear picture of how many people have developed immunity to the virus.

Contact tracing involves being able to quickly track down everyone who may have been exposed to a newly-diagnosed COVID-19 patient. Many countries have rolled out high-tech contact tracing systems that use smartphone GPS data to determine who was in contact with a new patient.
