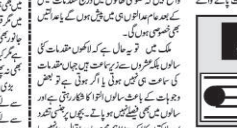

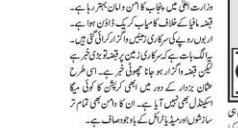

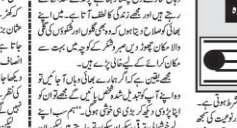

Here are Canadian immigration pathways for tech workers

Canada offers many visa pathways for global tech talent.

Canada's tech sector has been booming in recent years. Even in spite of the coronavirus pandemic, the sector remains strong with companies actively recruiting talent.

Due to its need for more ICT workers, Canada offers many permanent and temporary pathways to support the sector. These include general programs for skilled workers, and specific programs dedicated for tech talent.

Whether you wish to move to Canada on a permanent or temporary basis, the following are key options for you to consider.

Express Entry

Express Entry is Canada's main way of managing skilled worker applications for permanent residence. It is an extremely popular option for global tech talent looking to immigrate to Canada. Tech workers are the main occupational group of immigrants who move to Canada through Express Entry.

A major benefit of Express Entry is its dynamic and quick nature. You can successfully obtain an invitation to apply for permanent residence within just days of submitting a completed profile assuming that you are one of the highest-ranking candidates. If you are one of these lucky individuals, the federal government will aim to process your permanent residence application within six months of your submitting it.

If you are a tech worker who has not lived in Canada before, your best bet of being eligible for Express Entry is through the Federal Skilled Worker Program (FSWP). The FSWP accounts for nearly half of all individuals who obtain an ITA.

You need to meet minimum eligibility criteria and obtain at least 67 points to meet the FSWP's requirements. Before getting into the Express Entry pool of candidates, your eligibility for the FSWP will be determined by the likes of your age, education, language skills, and work experience.

Find out if you are eligible for Express Entry

Provincial Nominee Program (PNP)

The Provincial Nominee Program (PNP) is your next best bet for obtaining Canadian permanent residence if you have not lived in the country before.

Canada's Constitution gives the country's provinces and territories the right to operate immigration programs. The PNP operates in nearly every jurisdiction. Provinces can "nominate" immigration candidates that meet their labour market needs, and then the federal government goes ahead and processes their permanent residence application.

Provinces and territories offer general pathways for skilled workers as well as specific ones based on where they have labour shortages. Tech is a significant area of need, which is why some provinces operate tech streams.

Two of the most notable are offered by the provinces of Ontario and British Columbia.

The Ontario Tech Pilot is for workers who have experience in one of six tech occupations. Candidates need to have an Express Entry profile. Ontario has held two Tech Pilot draws in 2020, including one during the pandemic, in May, which saw over 700 candidates successfully receive invitations for provincial nomination.

B.C.'s Tech Pilot invites immigration candidates to apply for a provincial nomination on an almost weekly basis so long as they have a job offer in one of 29 tech occupations. The province has held 14 tech draws in 2020, including earlier this month, with over 1,500 people receiving provincial nominations so far this year.

Find out if you are eligible for any of Canada's skilled worker programs

Start-up Visa

The Canadian government also operates the Start-up Visa program. It exists to attract innovative entrepreneurs who are looking to operate a business in Canada. It is an attractive option for tech talent and has significantly different selection criteria from skilled worker programs. Notably, successful candidates need to be endorsed by an entity that is designated by the Canadian government (an angel investor, venture capital firm, or business incubator). Such entities are responsible for supporting the entrepreneur's success once they come to Canada.

Global Talent Stream

Canada offers plenty of temporary resident pathways for tech workers who either do not want to settle in Canada permanently, or want a quicker pathway into the country before submitting a permanent residence application. In fact, working in Canada temporarily can enhance your chances of obtaining permanent residence since many immigration programs such as the Canadian Experience Class (CEC) are meant to support this process.

Ontario Place will reopen to host events and festivals amid COVID-19 pandemic

The Ontario government will spend \$2 million to reopen Ontario Place in order to host on-site events and festivals amid the COVID-19 pandemic.

Minister of Tourism Lisa MacLeod made the announcement on Monday afternoon, just after the province revealed the regions that will be moving to Stage 3 of the province's reopening plan.

Toronto, where Ontario Place is located, remains in Stage 2 along with Peel and Windsor-Essex.

The minister stressed that there will be a limit on how many people can enter the government-owned theme park and entertainment venue, and that health measures such as physical distancing and hand hygiene will be upheld.

Outdoor gatherings were significantly increased in regions moving to Stage 3. Indoor gathering limits increase from 10 to a maximum of 50 people, while outdoor gathering limits increase to a maximum of 100 people. However, physical distancing is still required when gathering with people outside of one individual's social circle.

"COVID-19 has been difficult on all of us, and Ontario Place is a place of hope," MacLeod said. "And we need hope right now."

"In here to let Ontarians, and Torontonians in particular, know that the Ontario Place site will be activated and accessible to all Ontarians this summer."

MacLeod said that the cancellation or postponement of festivals and large events as a result of the pandemic has resulted in a \$20 billion loss in revenue across the province since the economy was shuttered in March.

Here are the five events and festivals planned for the summer lineup:

- o Lavazza Drive-In Film Festival starts Friday and will run until July 31, featuring a number of international films.
- o Toronto Shines is a pop-up drive-in festival featuring live entertainment, comedy and film. Toronto Shines will run through October.
- o DrivelnTO is an initiative launched by the City of Toronto that will offer free drive-in film screenings in August. Films will be provided by Hot Docs, imagineNATIVE and the Toronto International Film Festival (TIFF).
- o Toronto Undergraduate Jazz Festival will run on Sept. 5 to Sept. 6.
- o Toronto International Film Festival: TIFF will run from Sept. 10 to Sept. 19 and promises to host physical and digital screenings, drive-ins, as well as interactive talks and Q&As with casts and filmmakers.

Ontario Place will also continue to offer small boat rentals, dining at Vista Eatery patio, and access to walking trails.

"Ontario's heritage, sport, tourism and culture industries were hit first, the hardest, and will take the longest to recover from COVID-19," MacLeod said.

Toronto police charge 5 members of same family after drug investigation

Toronto police say they've charged five people from the same family after a gun and drugs investigation in the city.

Police offered few details as to what led to the probe, but say they searched two locations last week.

During those searches, they say they recovered 11 firearms, 1,100 rounds of ammunition, as well as large quantities of cocaine, heroin and crystal meth.

Anxiety high as Canadian schools prepare for students from COVID-ravaged U.S.

WASHINGTON - Post-secondary students from the pandemic-riven United States are ready to go back to school in Canada - a rite of passage that's causing more anxiety than usual for parents and front-line university workers alike in the age of COVID-19.

At Montreal's McGill University, some employees are growing worried the school prepares to welcome foreign students into on-campus residences, even those whose courses are entirely online.



giving U.S. parents sleepless nights. They're well aware of reports of Americans - accused of flouting travel restrictions - facing verbal abuse in Canada.

One mother, a dual citizen who heard tell of U.S. vehicles being vandalized, bought a looseleaf-sized notepad to attach to her second-year daughter's going into her second year at McGill, and who fears for her if her name is made public. The parents wrestled with whether to let her go.

"I kept saying to her, 'I would prefer you stay home and wait.' And she was like, 'But my life is waiting for me there.' So we're letting her make the choice."

"It is physically bitter-sweet," said the father of a second-year McGill student from a hard-hit southern state, who worried his child might be targeted. The good news, he said, is that his daughter "was made a connection, made a life and found a place in a culture and country that has some sense of the common good."

At the University of Toronto, where 23,000 international students comprised nearly a quarter of the school's 93,000-strong student body last year, a detailed and comprehensive plan is in motion to ensure the safety of all students, said Joe Wong, the school's vice-president and associate vice-president, international student experience.

Last year, U of T had 722 undergraduates and 514 graduate students from the U.S., and so far 268 new American students have accepted offers of admission, he said.

"All three levels of government are co-ordinating right now - they really are setting the bar high in terms of what is a safe and secure corridor for students and universities across the country," Wong said.

"I can't speak for others, but I know that they're all working very hard to and the plan that we put together at U of T... goes above and beyond what most people expected."

"There are a lot of family concerns related to health that are connected with this. And, you know, maybe I wouldn't be thinking about these things if I hadn't seen America erupt into chaos."

Others, however, have faith the institution can keep students and staff safe.

"Part of our mandate is to not only educate but nurture and protect those young adults," said Franco Taddio, who's worked in McGill's library system since the 1990s. "Honestly, as a father and Canadian, I would much rather have these students here for their safety and well-being than being in present-day America."

The novel coronavirus has infected more than 3.6 million people and killed 140,000 in the U.S., compared with 109,000 cases and 8,800 deaths in Canada. And it's not the only thing

How Ontario's largest school board plans to return in September

TORONTO - While school boards across Canada are quietly developing plans for bringing students back to class in September, the largest such organization in the country has taken things one step further by laying out a variety of scenarios in stark, costly detail.

Some of the models under consideration at the Toronto District School Board involve changing the way certain subjects are taught, while others raise public health and safety concerns among industry observers who fear COVID-19 will continue to present an imminent threat in the months ahead.

Here's a look at how things could play out for Toronto students and parents in the fall:

What has the provincial government proposed?

The Ministry of Education has asked all 72 of Ontario's school boards to prepare plans for three possible scenarios - a full-time return to in-person learning, virtual classes for all, or a hybrid model that combines the two.

Boards must submit plans for all scenarios by early August, which will then be subject to government approval before they can be implemented. Education Minister Stephen Lecce originally said hybrid learning was the government's preference, but has since indicated a preference to see all students back in class full-time.

So how is the Toronto board planning to comply with the provincial preferences?

Officials have mapped out different models for each of the three scenarios requested by the government, board spokesman Ryan Bird said in an interview. The most complex of these, he said, came about when considering a full-time return to classroom learning for students between kindergarten and Grade 8.

And each of them comes with a price tag, some hefty than others.

Option 1: Regular-length school days with no more than 15 students per class across the board. Bird says this option would cost the most, with the board needing \$249 million to hire about 2,500 extra teachers. Bird described this approach as "not that financially feasible."

Option 2: Same class sizes, but with the school day shortened by 48 minutes to allow teachers to have some prep time at the end of the day. Bird said this model would lower the cost to \$98 million.

Option 3: A full-day model with two different sizes of class cohorts - a maximum of 15 for students in kindergarten to Grade 3 and cohorts of 20 for Grade 4 and up. Bird estimates the board would need to hire 1,900 teachers at a cost of \$190 million if this plan goes ahead.

Option 4: Same mixed class sizes, but with the school day shortened by 48 minutes. Bird pegs the cost of hiring 200 teachers to support this approach at about \$20 million.

Option 5: Resuming pre-pandemic class sizes, but with additional, unspecified health and safety protocols. Bird said this approach is the one the board currently favours.

"We want all of our students back, and if we can do it in regular class sizes, we think that is ideal just from a mental health and well-being and learning aspect," he said. "Having said that, we know that the health and safety of our students and staff is the number one priority, so we have to make sure that whatever option is implemented... is safe to do."

Assuming the government approves something other than Option 5, does that mean classes will be taught as usual but in smaller numbers?

No, Bird said several subjects will have to be delivered differently than they were prior to the COVID-19 pandemic. Chief among these is French, he said, noting there aren't currently enough qualified teachers to staff a higher number of smaller classes. But that doesn't mean the course would disappear, he stressed, noting the board is looking at options such as virtual lessons delivered to in-person classes. The same principles apply to courses such as music, art and physical education, he said.

What do the experts think?

Charles Pascale, a former Ontario deputy minister of education and current professor at the University of Toronto's Ontario Institute for Studies in Education, praised the board for laying out their proposals and projections for public discussion. Jennifer Brown, president of the local chapter of the Elementary Teachers Federation of Ontario, said every proposal comes with obvious drawbacks. But she said she would personally support the one that best protects students and staff alike, even if it means shifting courses like French to virtual models that are generally less effective.

"There's shields up at banks, grocery stores, any service area," Brown said. "With our youngest and most vulnerable, we don't seem to have that same type of intentionality when it comes to safety. 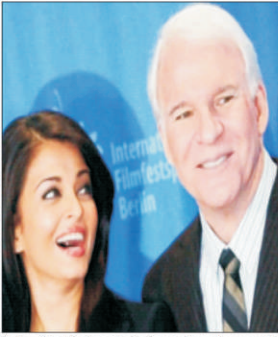
Pink Panther co-star Steve Martin wishes Aishwarya Rai Bachchan a speedy recovery

been a red flag next to players initiating reviews. When cricketers are playing for their living self-preservation often the DRS is a priority.

When the system was first considered, one of the reasons put forward for its introduction was to protect a player's career from a poor decision. In my time as a player, I've never seen a promising career curtailed by a DRS decision.

Cricket administrators often fail in their duty to visualise where a law or a playing condition will eventually lead. In its original form the DRS smacked of reaching a conclusion that "seemed like a good idea at the time." The three reviews per innings looked suspiciously like replicating the number used by tennis. The review system for tennis makes sense as all decisions are about a line; it's simple is it or out? Cricket decision making is more complicated with dismissals like lbw and caught and therefore is much trickier for everyone, technology

Canada: three killed in glacier tour bus crash in Alberta

The bus was on the steep road to the famed Athabasca glacier when it lost control and rolled.

A glacier tour bus rolled over in the Canadian province of Alberta, killing three people and injuring several, according to reports.

A sightseeing bus carrying 27 passengers overturned on route to the glacier near the Columbia Icefield in Alberta's Jasper National Park, according to reports by CBC.

CBC News said the incident involved one of the off-road buses that ferry visitors onto the glacier, owned by Pursuit, the company that operates tours of the ice fields, which are part of the Athabasca Glacier.

Three adults were killed, and several emergency workers and fire departments were descending on the scene, the report said, citing The Royal Canadian Mounted Police (RCMP).

Critically injured passengers were being transported from the crash site to various Alberta hospitals on helicopter ambulances, it said.

The report said several hospitals in the province were preparing to receive patients, some in critical or serious condition, citing a spokesperson for Alberta Health Services.

RCMP are investigating the cause of the roll-over with the support of a collision analyst, according to CBC News.

88% of Canada's coronavirus cases are considered recovered

Canada's novel coronavirus recovery numbers saw a significant boost on Friday as the province of Quebec tweaked the way it counts recoveries, adding thousands of resolved cases in one day.

Quebec is now reporting nearly 50,000 recoveries, while overall there are more than 96,000 resolved cases across the country.

The Institut national de santé publique du Québec (INSPQ) said it's using a new way to calculate recoveries as of Friday. The previous method resulted in "significant underestimations" of recovered cases.

This means 88 per cent of Canada's total tally of 109,645 COVID-19 cases are considered recovered as of Friday.

Meanwhile, the country reported 409 new cases on Friday, mostly from Quebec and Ontario, along with 12 deaths. Quebec remains the highest contributor to Canada's national caseload and overall death toll.

Deputy chief public health officer Howard Njoo called the recent surge in Canada's cases worrying and possibly linked to young people gathering in bars and parties.

Coronavirus Provinces can reopen as long as public health capacity is present, Dr. Njoo says.

"When we examine recent trends in case reporting, there is some cause for concern. After a period of steady decline, daily case counts have started rising," he told a briefing.

More than 400 cases were reported in Canada on Thursday, for instance, with spikes in Quebec, Alberta and Saskatchewan.

Friday saw Quebec record 141 cases, for a total of more than 57,000 cases. The death toll rose by one, to 5,647. The province has seen daily cases top 100 since July 11.

Premier François Legault said bars will not be shut down for now, as the recent spike in cases seems to stem from private parties as opposed to bars.

Ontario reported 111 new cases and nine new deaths, bringing total figures to more than 37,000 cases and 2,700 deaths. Nearly 90 per cent of Ontario's cases are considered recovered.

Nova Scotia has seen 63 deaths and more than 1,000 cases. It has two active cases at the moment.



Alberta saw 105 new cases and two new deaths. Thursday was the first time in over two months that the province recorded more than 100 cases in a single day.

Friday continued that trend. The total caseload in Alberta now rests at more than 9,200 cases, with 859 active ones, and 167 deaths.

The pandemic virus is mutating, but there's no need to panic. British Columbia reported 28 new cases, the highest single-day total since early May, and no new deaths, leaving B.C. with 3,181 confirmed cases.

The province's health officer Dr. Bonnie Henry said the number of exposures linked to private parties in Kelowna has grown to 35. There are also outbreaks at a work camp and a neonatal ICU.

Saskatchewan grew closer to 1,000 cases on Friday, as 13 new cases were announced. Hospitalizations have increased from three on Monday to 12 on Friday. Fifteen people have died so far in the province.

Manitoba saw five new cases, all from one Hutterite colony, bringing the provincial caseload to 320 confirmed cases. Seven people have died so far.

All four Atlantic provinces have once again reported no new cases on Friday. New Brunswick is left with three active cases, with no new ones reported on Friday.

Nunavut announced two presumptive cases of COVID-19 on July 15, with lab confirmation expected next week.

Worldwide, the coronavirus has resulted in nearly 14 million cases and more than 590,000 deaths, according to data tracked by Johns Hopkins University. The U.S. has the highest caseload and death toll in the world, followed by Brazil.

Police notified of 21,422 cases where travellers to Canada may have broken quarantine rules

OTTAWA -- Police have been notified for follow-up in more than 21,000 cases where travellers arriving in Canada either couldn't be reached or showed "indication of non-compliance" with the mandatory 14-day quarantine rules.

Of the 21,422 referrals from the Public Health Agency of Canada (PHAC) to the RCMP, nearly 1,500 were identified as "priority cases" for physical check-ups.

The RCMP and PHAC both confirmed the figures to CTV News -- though few punishments have been doled out to any suspected rule-breakers.

"To date, 9 tickets have been reported to PHAC as being issued under the Contraventions Act for offences under the Quarantine Act, four of which were issued following a request made by PHAC for a physical verification (2 fines were issued by RCMP and 2 by the Ontario Provincial Police)," PHAC spokesperson Geoffrey

referred information to both PHAC and the RCMP on 237 travellers who the CBSA believes may not have respected the requirement to quarantine or isolate and/or those who have signalled an unwillingness to comply," said CBSA spokesperson Rebecca Purdy in another emailed statement on Tuesday.

Canada shut its borders to foreigners in mid-March, initially exempting U.S. residents from the new rules. But within days the Canada-U.S. border had also

Canada-China relations committee to hold virtual meetings as pandemic stretches on

The parliamentary committee on Canada-China relations can now hold virtual meetings as coronavirus cases around the world continue to climb and tensions between Beijing and the West continue to worsen.

In a motion passed on Monday, the House of Commons added the high-profile and newly formed committee to the list of those allowed to hold virtual meetings as regular parliamentary sittings remain largely suspended as a result of the coronavirus pandemic.

As well, the public safety committee will also be able to hold its meetings virtually.

Regular House of Commons proceedings have been suspended since March when the federal parties agreed to suspend them in a bid to limit the spread of the highly contagious coronavirus.

Since then, members of Parliament have been meeting in hybrid formats including limited formal sittings of

the House of Commons and meetings four times per week -- prior to the summer -- of a special coronavirus committee that saw some members in the building and most participating virtually.

Committee work also stalled initially but has since moved online,

with a May 26 motion setting out a limited number of committees that could move to the new and experimental format.

That list of seven committees included the ones responsible for health, finance and government operations, as well as industry.

The total number of committees working online rises now to nine with the addition of the Canada-China relations committee and the public safety committee to that list.

The move comes as tensions with China continue to grow over its implementation of a national security law in Hong Kong that dismantles that country's democracy and has led Canada, Australia and the U.S. to suspend extradition and trade treaties that granted special status to the former British colony.

It also comes as the World Health Organization continues work on the early stages of a probe into the origins of the coronavirus pandemic and the handling of the outbreak.

The WHO has faced fierce criticism over concerns it relied too heavily on Chinese data and false information that cost precious time in responding to the early outbreak.

Legault-Thivierge confirmed in an emailed statement sent to CTV News on Tuesday evening. "As of July 9, 2020, no arrests have stemmed from PHAC-requested physical verification checks."

In addition to these latest figures, Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) confirmed to CTV News.ca that some travellers indicated a desire not to comply with Canada's rules as early as the moment they travelled across the border.

"As of July 3, 2020, the CBSA has

shuttered to all non-essential travel, an agreement that sources told CTV News on Tuesday would be extended to August 21.

As Canada shut its borders to all non-essential foreign travel, it also imposed a mandatory 14-day quarantine rule on March 21 for any travellers who do squeeze past the tightened ports of entry.

According to Deputy Chief Public Health Officer Dr. Howard Njoo, most travellers are happy to play by the rules.

"Most people from what I've seen, in terms of the data that's come in, have been very good in terms of what we call compliance. They accept the calls, they recognize that we're doing it not to badge or bound them, but really as a gentle reminder to continue doing what's, I think, in their best interests in terms of their health, but also to protect others," Njoo said in a Tuesday press conference.

The news of thousands of suspected rule-breakers emerges as COVID-19 cases explode on the other side of the world's longest international border.

At the end of June, the U.S. became home to the world's highest number of reported infections: more than 2.2 million. That number has since soared to more than 3.4 million, according to the New York Times, with more than 136,000 deaths.
