# Long COVID plan, funding decisions in the works, Ontario's top doctor says

Ontario is expected to make funding decisions for a long COVID strategy in the near future, the

strategy in the near future, the province's top doctors says, as health officials work to create standard definitions and treatment protocols. Hospitals have been submitting proposals to Ontario Health, and now the province is working to provide guidance to primary care professionals on how to care for patients with long COVID symptoms, Chief Medical Officer of Health Dr. Kieran Moore said.

"I've seen the proposals and I don't want to pre-empt any ministry announcements, but I think they're about to make some funding decisions in the near future," Moore

said in a recent interview.



inflation in Canada are likely to peak in the fourth quarter of this year, economists told Reuters, though most see signs fast rising prices are becoming entrenched and warn a recession may be needed to avoid a

Canada's inflation data for August will be released on Tuesday, with analysts forecasting the headline rate will dege down to 7.3 per cent, from 7.5 per cent in July and a four decade high 67st J per cent in June. But all eyes will be on the three core measures of inflation - CPI Common, CPI Median and CPI Tim - which taken logher are seen as a better indicator of underlying price pressures.

The average of the three hit a record high of 5.3 per cent in July.
Six of eight economists surveyed by Reuters see core inflation peaking in the fourth quarter as underlying domestic and global pressures start to



ease, though the path back to the two per cent target will not be brisk. "Rapiddly cooling growth, the pullback in housing prices, and less pressure on supply chains will belp cap core inflation relatively soon," said Doug Porter, chief economist at HMC/Cenité Morkete.
