Harassment complaints at House of Commons rise more than 60% year over year: report

workplace violence and harassment in the House of Commons almost doubled year over year and is now more than six times higher than it was two years ago, according to a newly published parliamentary report.

In 2022-23 there were 13 omplaints made, eight of which were made against someone who does not work for the House of Commons,

Of the remaining five cases included in the report, four were made against an employee or colleague of a Member of Parliament, while one complaint was made against an MP. The report does not detail which allegations were made against an MP. people. In January 2021 the House of Commons implemented a new workplace harassment and violence

prevention policy strengthening reporting requirements, and mandating MPs and staff take part in

mandating MPs and staff take part in training sessions on workplain conduct.

The training covers several forms of histories and violence prevention and also covers the abuse of power by MPs.


